Many are chosen to be “Teachers of the Year” in their schools, some are hired as educational or reading specialists, and others pursue advanced degrees. All are advocates for children and adolescents, implementing best practices in school environments.

Diverse learning opportunities

Education Programs offered at Texas Wesleyan include Exercise Science, Athletic Training/Sports Medicine, and EC-Grade 4 (Generalist/Bilingual). The Middle School (Grades 4-8) offers certifications in English/Language Arts/Reading with ESL, English/Language Arts/Reading/Social Studies with ESL, Generalist with ESL, Mathematics with ESL, Science with ESL, Science with ESL, and Social Studies with ESL. Minors are also offered in Kinesiology and Recreation Diving Management.

Internship programs

The education community agrees that traditional student teaching experiences, which usually last 10-14 weeks, often do not prepare new teachers for the demands of today’s classroom. With this in mind, the faculty have developed an internship program to supplement traditional student teaching. This program places students in real classrooms sooner and for two complete semesters. By doing so, students will be able to bridge theory with practice and have an entire year of experience before they graduate. Paid internships are often available.

Education courses

Students majoring in education select from a wide variety of interesting courses, including Computers as a Classroom Tool, Infant and Child Development, Roles and Responsibilities for Teachers and Studies in Multicultural Education. Depending on the certification program, students also engage in a variety of courses such as: ESL Methodology, Language Arts, Literacy, Mathematics and Social Studies.
