**Texas Wesleyan University presents “Landscapes: One To One” exhibition**

FORT WORTH, Jan. 16 – Texas Wesleyan University’s Department of Art presents its “Landscapes: One to One” exhibition from Jan. 21 through Feb. 21, with an opening reception and gallery talk by the artists on Thursday, Jan. 23 from 5:30-6:30 p.m. The exhibition will be in the East Room Gallery of the Eunice and James L. West Library, located at 1201 Wesleyan St. The art exhibition is free and open to the public, with viewing hours Monday through Saturday 9 a.m.-5 p.m. and Sunday 2-5 p.m.

The exhibition will feature artists Andy Anderson, Richard Ash, Lyle Novinsky, John Weinkein and their creative partners. Each of the participants in the exhibition was asked to choose a creative partner, who may or may not be an artist, and create two works that relate in some manner. The exhibition is the second of a two-part series hosted by Texas Wesleyan’s Department of Art and focuses on a theme of landscapes. The landscapes theme can be interpreted literally or broadly.

John Weinkein, chair of the department of visual arts at Texas Woman’s University, is exhibiting three wood and stone sculptures with mixed media. He is partnering with Christine

Shank, who will be creating photographic works in conjunction with Weinkein's sculptures.

Lyle Novinsky is exhibiting two paintings in conjunction with two poems by his creative partner, Dr. Garth Barbee, a Virginia physician.

Andy Anderson is partnering with his wife Terri Cummings, visiting assistant professor of art with Texas Wesleyan University.

Richard Ash is the chair of the art department at Midwestern State University in Wichita Falls and will be exhibiting a screenprint. His creative partner, Walter W. Nelson, will be exhibiting a photograph.
