Texas Wesleyan University announces Thomas H. Law Scholarship award

FORT WORTH, Oct. 28 – Texas Wesleyan University’s School of Business names senior Thomasina T. Delancy, an economics and finance major, as the Thomas H. Law Scholarship recipient for 2003-04. A formal awards ceremony will be held Thursday, Oct. 30 at the Fort Worth Club.

The Thomas H. Law Scholarship is awarded annually to an exemplary undergraduate business major and is chosen by the faculty from the Wesleyan School of Business. Established in 1998, this scholarship was named in honor of Thomas H. Law, a former recipient of the Outstanding Business Executive of the Year award.

Delancy came to Texas in 1996 from Nassau, Bahamas, and later graduated from Paschal High School. Delancy enrolled at Texas Wesleyan University after being awarded an International Student Scholarship in 1997. An active member of the student body, Delancy is involved in the Wesleyan Student Foundation, the International Club, and Sigma Beta Delta, an international honor society. Delancy currently serves as the Wesleyan Student Government treasurer. Additionally, Delancy performed as a Wesleyan singer her freshman and junior years,
