**Texas Wesleyan University presents faculty piano recital  
“Piano Music of the First Viennese School”**

FORT WORTH, Oct. 31 – The music department at Texas Wesleyan University will present “Piano Music of the First Viennese School” during a faculty piano recital on Tuesday, Nov. 11. The recital will begin at 7:30 p.m. in Nicholas Martin Hall, located at 1201 Wesleyan St. in the Ann Waggoner Annex on the corner of Wesleyan and Rosedale. Admission is free and open to the public.

Pianists John Fisher, professor of music, and Bruce McDonald, professor of philosophy and religion, will perform piano music by Mozart and Beethoven. Dr. Fisher will play the Piano Sonata in A minor, K. 310 of Mozart, and Dr. McDonald will showcase Beethoven’s Piano Sonata in E-flat Major, Op. 27, No. 1. The two faculty colleagues will present in unison Mozart’s Sonata for Two Pianos in D Major, K. 448.
