Texas Wesleyan University announces rise in spring credit hours

FORT WORTH, Feb. 5 – Texas Wesleyan University’s spring enrollment credit hours have increased from 26,367 in spring 2003 to 26,557 in spring 2004. Undergraduate enrollment of 1,305 students is comparable to last spring’s total of 1,302, and the total number of students currently enrolled is 2,246. Credit hours have increased in all Texas Wesleyan University graduate programs, including nurse anesthesia and the schools of business, education and law. Overall enrollment for the Graduate Program of Nurse Anesthesia, the largest program of its kind in the nation, is up 2.3 percent from the spring 2003 enrollment numbers, with 221 students enrolled.

Wesleyan President Harold Jeffcoat attributes the rising enrollment numbers to improved retention, aggressive recruiting and affordable, quality academics at Texas Wesleyan.
