Texas Wesleyan exceeds fall credit-hour projections

FORT WORTH, Sept. 12 – Texas Wesleyan University enrolled 2,607 students for the fall and exceeded its 2004 credit-hour projections. Vice President of Enrollment and Student Services Patricia Alexander says the growth can be credited to an 8 percent increase in transfer students and to the university's flourishing graduate programs, two of which are new at Wesleyan: the Master of Science in healthcare administration and the Master of Science in psychology, with a concentration in mental health counseling.

Texas Wesleyan University has a solid graduate program in education, a competitive MBA program, and the nation's largest graduate program of nurse anesthesia, which is the first and only accredited program of its kind to offer its entire curriculum as a long distance learning option. The Texas Wesleyan University School of Law is rapidly becoming a rising leader in legal education in Texas.
