**Student artists to display creative expressions
at coffeehouse exhibition**

FORT WORTH, July 1 – Texas Wesleyan University students Thad Burns, Cortney Johansen, Roy Marley and Melissa Rodriguez will display original photographic art from July 3 to July 31 at the Art of Espresso coffeehouse and gallery in Fort Worth, located at 8650 Meadowbrook Blvd. in suite J. A “meet the artists” reception will be held on Friday, July 9 at 5-7 p.m.

The exhibition, titled Through Our Lenses, delivers a diverse cross-section of photography styles. Burns explores conceptions, perceptions and illusions of three-dimensional space using traditional black and white gelatin silver prints. Marley comments on the interaction of graphics in our environment through high contrast black and white images with digitally inserted signage. Using a digital camera, Johansen creates a dream-like world with her image-shifting prints, whereas Rodriguez reflects the creative passions of her subjects through silver gelatin portraits.

All artwork will be on sale during the exhibition. Gallery hours are Monday through Thursday from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m., Saturday from 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. and Sunday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
