Guitar Fort Worth and Texas Wesleyan University present renowned classical guitarist Virginia Luque in the Wesleyan Masters Concert Series

FORT WORTH, Sept. 24 – Guitar Fort Worth and the Texas Wesleyan University Department of Music present the Wesleyan Masters Concert Series, a series of five concerts featuring renowned classical guitarists soloists Virginia Luque, Tom Sheeley, Alfonso Moreno, Ana Vidovic and Eduardo Fernandez. The first concert in the series is Friday, Oct. 1 at 7:30 p.m. in Nicholas Martin Hall, inside the Ann Waggoner Fine Arts Building, located at 1309 Wesleyan St. on Texas Wesleyan’s historic campus. The collaboration between Guitar Fort Worth and Texas Wesleyan University was created through the efforts of Michael Dailey, adjunct professor of guitar at Wesleyan and an affiliate of Guitar Fort Worth.

Virginia Luque, a native of Cadiz, Spain, has been moving audiences since the age of seven. She studied under the great Spanish guitarist Andres Segovia and received a master’s degree from an institute in Spain and a second master’s degree from the Juilliard School of Music in New York. An accomplished guitarist, Virginia has received many distinctions: first prize at the Manuel de Falla International Competition for Classical guitar; awarded the prestigious
