Texas Wesleyan University celebrates homecoming

FORT WORTH, Feb. 11 – Texas Wesleyan University will celebrate homecoming Feb. 24-28 with a series of fun activities and events coordinated by the student life office to increase student activity. The homecoming basketball game will be Feb. 28 at 7:30 p.m. against Balcone College in the Sid W. Richardson Center, located at 1100 S. Collard on the Wesleyan campus. A school-wide dance, held in the Brown-Lupton Campus Center (The Quad), will follow the game.

In the four days leading up to homecoming, students will dress according to a daily theme: crazy hat day on Tuesday, salad dressing day on Wednesday (students might wear cowboy boots to portray “ranch dressing”), spirit day on Thursday (students wear Wesleyan colors), and retro day on Friday. Faculty and staff will serve as judges to award the “best dressed” with prizes. Homecoming festivities also include a pep rally with a slam-dunk contest at noon, Feb. 24 in the Sid W. Richardson Center.
