**Guitar Fort Worth and Texas Wesleyan University present  
international competition winner Tom Sheeley in concert**

FORT WORTH, Oct. 22 – Guitar Fort Worth and the Texas Wesleyan University Department of Music present renowned classical guitarist soloist Tom Sheeley, as the second concert in the Wesleyan Masters Concert Series, a series of five classical guitar concerts. The concert will be Friday, Oct. 29 at 7:30 p.m. in Nicholas Martin Hall, inside the Ann Waggoner Fine Arts Building, located at 1309 Wesleyan St. on Texas Wesleyan’s historic campus.

Tom Sheeley has performed internationally in concerts and competitions such as the European International Festival in Geneva, Switzerland; the Concours Internationale de Guitare in Paris France, where he was invited to present a guest recital; and in Mexico City, Mexico, where he won first place in the Manuel M. Ponce International Guitar Competition. He has performed with well-known musical groups such as the Blair Quartet, The St. Petersburg Quartet, The Flagstaff Symphony Orchestra, The Flagstaff Festival of The Arts Summer Orchestra, The Sinfonica de Maracaibo Venezuela and The Sinofonica Nacional de Ecuador.

The Wesleyan Masters Concert Series features classical guitar soloists in individual concerts. These guest artists include Virginia Luque, Tom Sheeley, Alfonso Moreno, Ana
