**Texas Wesleyan University welcomes best-selling author  
Stephen Mansfield as guest lecturer**

FORT WORTH, Oct. 20 – Best-selling author and acclaimed speaker, Stephen Mansfield, will be the guest lecturer for Texas Wesleyan University's Willson Lecture Series. He will speak on faith and politics on Tuesday, Nov. 9 at 7 p.m. in Nicholas Martin Hall inside the Ann Waggoner Fine Arts Building, located at 1309 Wesleyan St. Mansfield's lecture will be followed by a question-and-answer session. A pre-event reception will be held at 6 p.m. on the second floor of the O'Neal Sells Administration Building, at 1201 Wesleyan St. The Willson Lecture Series and reception are free and open to the public.

Mansfield has written several books, including the following: *Never Give In: The Extraordinary Character of Winston Churchill*, which was a finalist for the Gold Medallion Book Award; *Then Darkness Fled: The Liberating Legacy of Booker T. Washington*; *Forgotten Founding Father: The Heroic Legacy of George Whitefield*; and *Faithful Volunteers*, which he co-authored with George Grant for Tennessee's bicentennial in 1997. The governor of Tennessee commissioned Mansfield to write *Faithful Volunteers*. Mansfield's latest book, *The Faith of George W. Bush*, was on the New York
