Texas Wesleyan University will hold its annual Academic Convocation at 12:05 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 13, in Martin Hall, located in the Ann Waggoner Fine Arts Building, 1309 Wesleyan St. John Maddux, chairman of the Board of Trustees, will be the guest speaker. He will be introduced by Dr. Harold Jeffcoat, president of Texas Wesleyan University.
