TEXAS WESLEYAN HOSTING SCIENCE LAB DAY FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Area high school students will have the opportunity to experience the sciences in a university setting, interact with faculty and students, and explore career opportunities during Science Laboratory Participation Day, hosted by Texas Wesleyan University. Science Laboratory Participation Day will run from 8:30 a.m. to 2:15 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 22, at the Ella C. McFadden Science Center, 1303 Wesleyan St. The event is open to area high school juniors and seniors.

Students will participate in three science laboratories chosen from four different disciplines: biology, chemistry, physics, or computer science. During lunch, students will learn about and discuss various careers in the fields of science, math and computer science. Pizza will be served. There is no registration fee.

Science Laboratory Participation Day will feature hands-on experiments in the Texas Wesleyan campus science and computer labs. Staff from the Office of Admission, Wesleyan students, and faculty from the departments of biology, chemistry, physics, mathematics and computer science will assist the high school students.
