

Announcing 2009-2010 Competitive Scholarship for Graduate Studies in Education programs for up to \$500!

Students who are pursuing the Master of Education degree may apply for a Competitive Scholarship for Graduate Studies in Education for up to \$500. Scholarships will be granted during the fall 2009 or spring 2010 semester, pending funding.

Eligibility for this scholarship may be dependent upon other financial assistance received. If this scholarship is greater than a current scholarship you are receiving, you may apply. But, if awarded, you must decline your current scholarship and will instead receive the Competitive Scholarship for Graduate Studies in Education.

The deadline for completed applications is October 15 – Fall and February 15 – Spring
